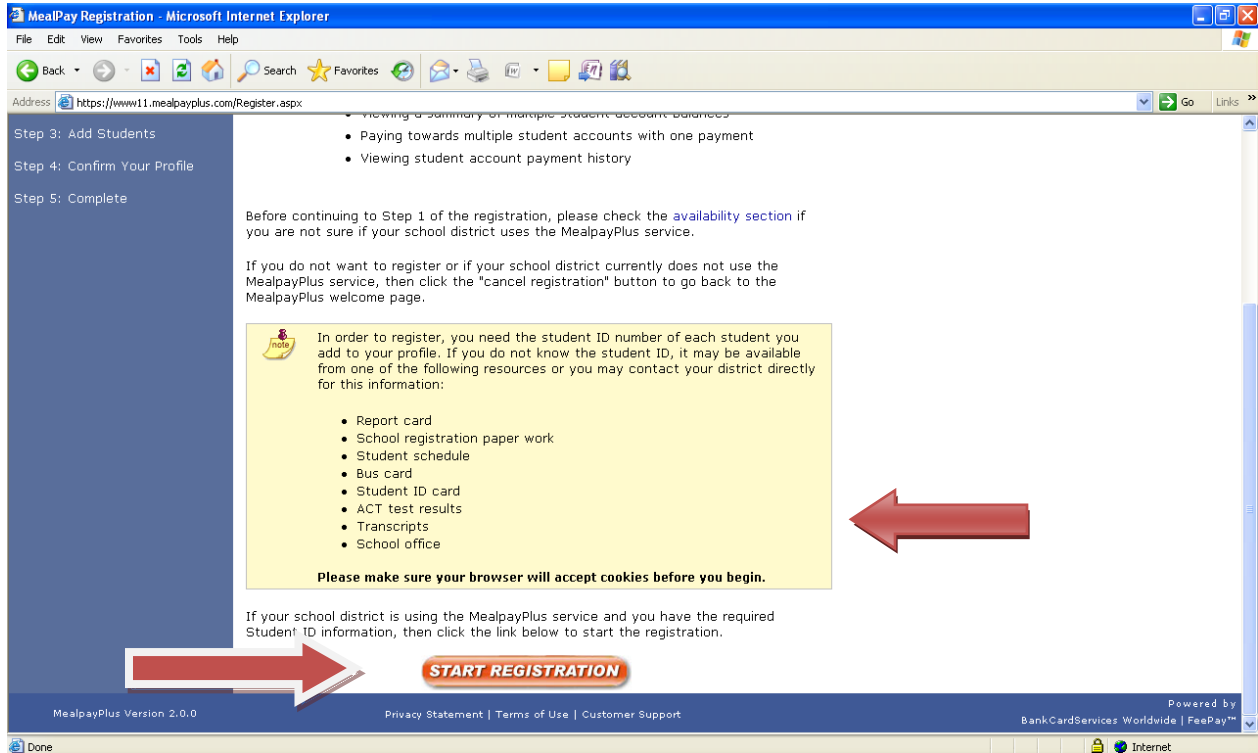


1. Using your Internet browser, navigate to www.mealpayplus.com. At the bottom of the screen, click 'K-12 Schools' under 'New User Registration.'

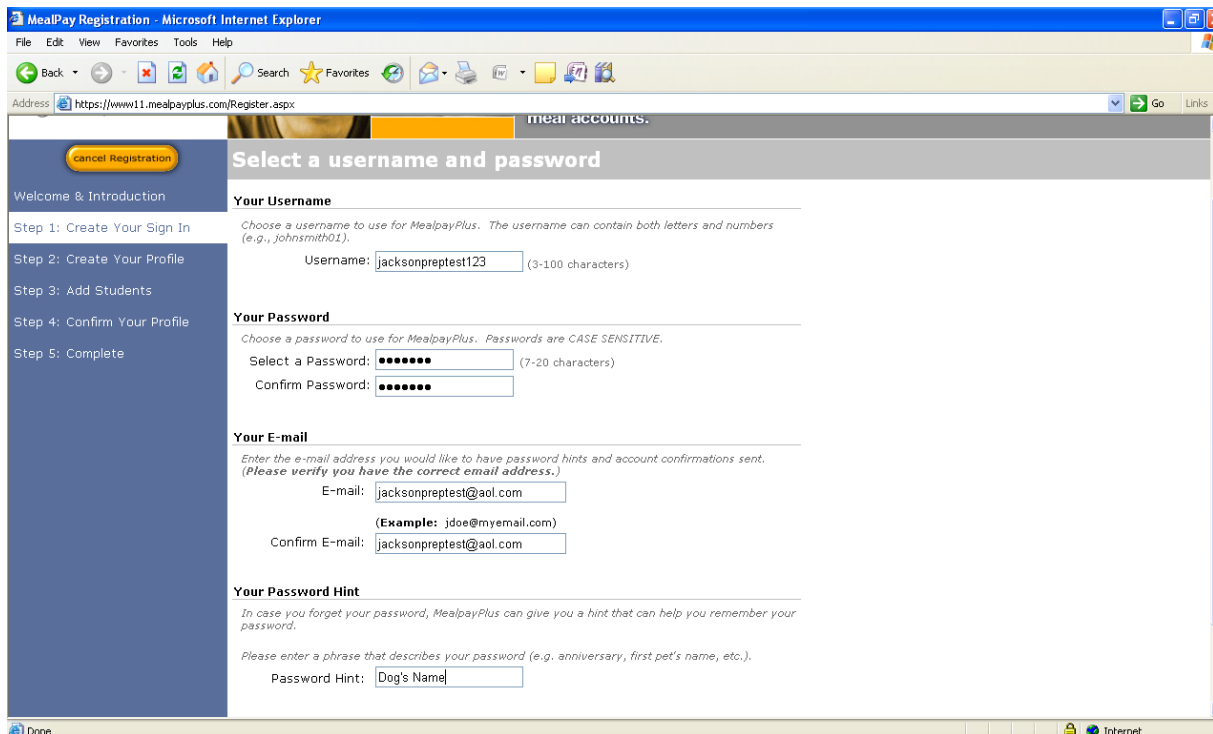
